She plans to breeze in and out, but then she sees Claire Sutherland, one of Astrid's stuck-up besties, and decides that maybe there's some fun (and a little retribution) to be had in Bright Falls, after all. Having raised her eleven-year-old daughter mostly on her own while dealing with her unreliable ex and running a bookstore, Claire Sutherland depends upon a life without surprises. And Delilah Green is an unwelcome surprise...at first. Though they've known each other for years, they don't really know each other—so Claire is unsettled when Delilah figures out exactly what buttons to push. When they're forced together during a gauntlet of wedding preparations—including a plot to save Astrid from her horrible fiancé—Claire isn't sure she has the strength to resist Delilah's charms. Even worse, she's starting to think she doesn't want to... Turning thirty sucks. Turning thirty and losing your job in the same week sucks so much it can lead to soul-crushing manic breakdowns; the kind that include announcing to one's friends and family that you're giving it all up for the sea. Bridget West knows as much about career advancement as she does workplace etiquette, and would sooner medicate a life challenge, than fix one. Her unruly ego, disdain for authority and misguided passion for fine beauty products have landed her in enough trouble over the years to know the value of a well told story. When she isn't reattaching the top level of her skin after clawing her way through the dark, monster-filled tunnel of life, Bridget can be found soaring upon the winds of inspiration, words appearing beneath her pen as if by magic. Her first novel, *Blue Hair Don't Care*, follows her experience of losing her job, becoming a mermaid, and giving up two legs in favor of a very good tale. Lola has curly hair which is much bigger than that of other kids at her school, but she tells anyone who listens how much she loves her hair. Designed to boost self-esteem and build confidence, this book is aimed at boys and girls who may need a reminder that it's okay to look different from the other kids at their school. *No Hair, Don't Care* is a story of how a mother and daughter learn to cope with the side effects of chemotherapy and hair loss in particular. During this journey, we see both mom and daughter rely on prayer, love, determination, and a positive attitude to help them overcome their fears. Lexie and her mom realize that all they need is love to keep their family together during such a critical time. This empowering book allows parents to engage their children in honest and encouraging discussions about cancer.
